

ORDINANCE NO. 1 AC - C.M.S.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY SOLICITOR TO  
SIGN CITY CHECKS IN THE ABSENCE OF THE REGULAR  
TREASURER

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Ohio,  
five-sevenths of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the City Solicitor be, and he is hereby  
authorized and empowered to sign city checks in place of the City  
Treasurer at all times in the absence of or incapacity of the City  
Treasurer.

SECTION 2: Due to the emergency existing, occasioned by the  
absence of the City Treasurer from Oberlin, Ohio, this Ordinance shall  
be retroactive to March 29, 1957.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency  
measure, the emergency being the preservation of the public peace,  
safety and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, and shall take  
effect as of March 29, 1957.
