ORDINANCE NO. 16 - AC. CMS

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH INDUSTRIAL MANUFACTURING ELECTRICAL RATE AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY THEREFOR

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the following Industrial Manufacturing Electrical Rate is hereby established:

<u>Applicable</u>

To secondary power and light service to industrial customers when the billing demand is not less than 200 KW and not more than 350 KW.

Character of Service

AC, 60 cycle, single phase, 120/208 volt, or 120/240 volts, 3 phase, 120/208 or 240 volts.

Rate

5.00¢ per KWH first 30 KWH per KW demand 2.00¢ per KWH next 70 KWH per KW demand Balance 1.25¢ per KWH Minimum Bill³1.50 per KVA of demand

Billing Demand

The maximum 30-minute measured KW demand during the month, but in no event less than 50 KW nor less than 60 percent of the highest KW demand measured during the preceeding 11 months, nor less than the contract demand.

Metering

Secondary.

Power Factor Adjustment

The above rates are based on the customer maintaining a power factor of 85% or better.

Should the power factor drop below 85% lagging during peak demand periods, the billing demand will be adjusted. The difference in demand created between the actual power factor and 85% power factor will be added to the billing demand.

Fuel Adjustment

Whenever the price of fuel oil delivered to the utility is more than lic or less than 8c per gallon the above rate will be adjusted. The rate will be increased by 0.1c per KWH for each 1c increase above 11c per gallon, or decreased by 0.1c per KWH for each 1c decrease below 8c per gallon.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being the preservation of health and safety of the citizens of Oberlin and shall take immediate effect upon its passage.
