

ORDINANCE No. 2 AC - C.M.S.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE
A LEASE TO THE NEW YORK CENTRAL RAILROAD SYSTEM FOR
THE USE OF FIFTY FEET OF TRACK AND TO DECLARE AN
EMERGENCY THEREFOR

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain
County, Ohio, five-sevenths of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the City Manager be, and he is hereby
authorized, to enter into a lease with the New York Central Railroad
System for the use of fifty feet of track in the sum of \$10.00.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency
measure, the emergency being the preservation of the public peace,
safety and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, and shall take
effect immediately upon passage.
