ORDINANCE NO. 22 AC - CMS

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND C.O. 915.14 AND TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS THEREOF IN CONFLICT THEREWITH AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY THEREPOR

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, five-sevenths of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That C.O. 915.14 be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

> "915.14 DETERMINATION OF CHARGES; WATER METERS REQUIRED. On premises using water supplied either in whole or in part from sources other than the waterworks system of ' the City, the City Manager may require the owner, or other interested party to install water meters satisfactory to the Manager to the extent necessary to measure all the supplies of water, to permit estimating by the City Manager of the sewage discharged into the system.

In the event it can be shown to the satisfaction of the City Manager with respect to any premises, that a portion of the water from any source on the premises does not and cannot enter the system, then en each such case, the owner or other interested party, shall at his expense, install and maintain metering devices to the extent necessary to demonstrate to the satisfaction of the Manager the portion of the water consumed on the premises which is discharged into the system, which portion shall constitute the basis for measuring the sewer charge for the premises."

SECTION 2: That all Ordinances or parts thereof in conflict herewith are expressly repealed.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being the preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, and shall take immediate effect upon its passage.
