

ORDINANCE NO. 26 A.C. - C.M.S.

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF PROUT CHEVROLET
FOR THE FURNISHING OF A POLICE CRUISER TO THE
CITY OF OBERLIN

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin,
Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7's) of all members elected
thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Prout Chevrolet being the
lowest and best bid for the furnishing of a 1958 Chevrolet to the
City of Oberlin, be and the same is hereby accepted, and the City
Manager is hereby authorized to enter into contract accordingly.
The bid being \$1241.53.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be
an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the
public peace, property and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio,
and shall take immediate effect upon passage.
