

ORDINANCE NO. 33 AC - C.M.S.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE NO. 3 AC C.M.S., TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, five-sevenths of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 3 AC - C.M.S. be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2. That Section 1143.03 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, be and the same is amended to read as follows:

Section 1143.03 Before a license is granted to any applicant, and before any expiring license is renewed, the applicant shall pay the City of Oberlin a fee in such an amount as herein specified. Upon determination that the purposes of this title and the public interest will not be hindered, the licensing board shall have the power to waive the respective licensing requirements as to technical qualifications and grant the license upon payment of the appropriate fee and the posting of the appropriate bonds in cases of applicants who are licensed contractors in the respective fields in other cities which require licenses for the contractors in the same field for which the particular license in question is being applied for, and which allow electricians licensed by the City to do work in such other municipalities by virtue of the license granted by the City.

Electricians License \$20.00

Renewal \$10.00

Any license renewed after the 31st day of January, shall be \$20.00

SECTION 2. That all ordinances or parts thereof in conflict herewith are expressly repealed.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, and shall take immediate effect upon passage.
