## ORDINANCE NO. 4 A.C. - C.M.S.

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF THE MARKS TRACTOR AND EQUIPMENT COMPANY FOR THE FURNISHING OF A GRADER TO THE CITY OF OBERLIN
