

ORDINANCE NO. 4 A.C. - C.M.S.

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF THE MARKS
TRACTOR AND EQUIPMENT COMPANY FOR THE
FURNISHING OF A GRADER TO THE CITY OF OBERLIN

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin,
Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7's) of all members elected
thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of the Marks Tractor and
Equipment Company being the lowest and best bid for the furnishing
of a used grader to the City of Oberlin, be and the same is hereby
accepted.

SECTION 2. That the charge for this tractor shall be
\$7,072.62, and the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into
contract accordingly.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be
an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the
public peace, property and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio,
and shall take immediate effect upon passage.
