ORDINANCE NO. 100 AC - C.M.S.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 41 AC - CMS AND SECTION 307.01 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO, AND TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS THEREOF IN CONFLICT HEREWITH

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That Section 307.01 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 307.01: Impounding of Vehicles: "Any police officer may impound any vehicle parked at a place where parking is prohibited, or which has been parked for more than one hour in excess of the time allowed for more than one hour in excess of the time allowed for parking in any place or which has improper or expired license plates, or which lacks equipment required by law, or which has been involved in two or more violations of traffic ordinances for which citation tags have been issued and not presented. The storage charges and/or towing charges for said vehicle shall be the responsibility of the owner of said vehicle and the City shall not assume any responsibility or costs thereof."

SECTION 2: Ordinance No. 41 AC - C.M.S. is hereby repealed.
