

ORDINANCE NO. 37 AC - C.M.S.

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF MILNER
ELECTRIC COMPANY FOR THE FURNISHING OF
TRANSMISSION LINE ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT
AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin,
Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7's) of all members elected
thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Milner Electric Company
being the lowest and best bid for the furnishing of transmission
line electrical equipment to the City of Oberlin, be and the same
is hereby accepted, and the City Manager is hereby authorized to
enter into contract accordingly. The bid being \$19,697.78.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be
an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of
the public peace, property and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin,
Ohio, to wit: The operation of the Municipal Light Plant.
