## ORDINANCE NO. 40 AC C.M.S.

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE INVESTMENT OF TREASURY FUNDS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, State of Ohio, a majority of members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. Whenever there are monies in the Treasury of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, which will not be required to be used for a period of six (6) months or more, such monies may in lieu of being deposited in a bank, or banks, be invested in accordance with the provisions of the Ohio Revised Code Sections 731.56, 731.57, 731.58 and 731.59. Investments so purchased shall be sold in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 731.57.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
