ORDINANCE NO. 41 AC - C.M.S.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 307.01, CHAPTER 7  
OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN,  
OHIO, AND TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS THERE-  
OF IN CONFLICT HERewith

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Ohio,  
five sevenths (5/7's) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Section 307.01 of the Codified Ordinances  
of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, be and the same is hereby amended to  
read as follows:

Section 307.01: Impounding of Vehicles: "Any police  
officer may impound any vehicle parked at a place  
where parking is prohibited, or which has been parked  
for more than one hour in excess of the time allowed  
for parking in any place, or which has improper or  
expired license plates, or which lacks equipment  
required by law, or which has been involved in two  
or more violations of traffic ordinances for which  
citation tags have been issued and not presented.  
Any person desiring to redeem such impounded vehicle  
shall first pay to the Police Department a towing  
charge of not more than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and in  
addition, shall pay a storage charge of not more than  
Two Dollars (\$2.00) per day for the time said  
impounded vehicle is in storage. In addition to any  
towing and storage charges the person redeeming a  
vehicle shall pay the amount due for any fine or  
fines assessed for violations of this Traffic Code."

SECTION 2. That all ordinances or parts thereof in conflict  
therewith are hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect  
from the earliest period allowed by law.
