

ORDINANCE NO. 43 AC - C.M.S.

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF MARBLE CLIFF
QUARRIES FOR THE FURNISHING OF LIME AND TO
DECLARE SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin,
Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7's) of all members elected
thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the bid of Marble Cliff Quarries, being
the lowest and best bid, for the furnishing of Lime, be and the
same is hereby accepted and the City Manager is hereby authorized
to enter into a contract accordingly, the bid being \$16.25 plus
handling.

SECTION 2: That this ordinance is hereby declared
to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation
of the public peace, property and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin,
Ohio, to-wit: the operation of the water works plant, and shall
take effect immediately upon passage.
