

ORDINANCE NO. 46 AC - C.M.S.

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF OKONITE COMPANY  
FOR THE FURNISHING OF GROUP 1 INTERIOR WIRING AND  
TO DECLARE SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain  
County, Ohio, five-sevenths of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Okonite Company being the lowest  
and best bid for the furnishing of Group 1, Interior Wiring, be and  
the same is hereby accepted and the City Manager is hereby authorized  
to enter into a contract accordingly, the bid being \$1,750.

SECTION 2: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an  
emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the  
public peace, property and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio,  
to-wit: the operation of the Municipal Light Plant and shall take  
effect immediately upon passage.
