

ORDINANCE NO. 49 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF JANBY OIL
COMPANY FOR THE FURNISHING OF GASOLINE, OIL
AND AUTOMOTIVE SUPPLIES

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin,
Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths of all members elected thereto
concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Janby Oil Company being
the lowest and best bid for the furnishing of gasoline, oil and
automotive supplies be and the same is hereby accepted, and the
City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract
accordingly.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in
full force from the earliest period allowed by law.
