AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH FAIRBANKS-MORSE FOR EMERGENCY REPAIRS AT THE MUNICIPAL LIGHT & POWER PLANT AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, five-sevenths of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION I. That the City Manager be, and he is hereby authorized, to enter into a contract with Fairbanks-Morse & Company for emergency repairs to engine number one, in the amount of \$20,726.80.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit: the operation of the municipal light plant, and shall take immediate effect upon its passage.
