

ORDINANCE NO. 54 - AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 41, SECTION
1141.04 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE
CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Oberlin,
Lorain County, Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto
concurring:

SECTION 1: That the Codified Ordinance 1141.04 be and
the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 1141.04. PERMIT REQUIRED. No person shall
engage in the business of installing, maintaining,
altering or repairing for others, any electric
wiring, devices, appliances or equipment unless such
person shall first obtain a permit from the City.
Permits shall be required for all electrical work
except minor repairs as defined in the section of
the Ohio Building Code governing definitions and for
all electrical maintenance work done by the employees
of any firm, person or corporation that has a full
time electrical maintenance force."

SECTION 2. Any person, firm or corporation that has a
full time electrical maintenance force shall in lieu of the permits
otherwise required pay an annual permit fee of One Hundred Dollars
(\$100.00).

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take full force and be
in effect from the earliest period allowed by law.
