

ORDINANCE NO. 71 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROVE THE LEASING OF CERTAIN  
PROPERTY FROM THE NEW YORK CENTRAL RAILROAD  
COMPANY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Oberlin, O  
Lorain County, Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto  
concurring:

SECTION 1: That the offer of the New York Central Railroad  
Company to lease the following described property to the City of  
Oberlin, Ohio for a rental of Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) per year  
be and the same is hereby accepted under the conditions and limita-  
tions contained in said offer.

Situated in the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain and  
State of Ohio, and being a certain strip of land 32  
feet in width and approximately 670 feet in length,  
containing 21,440 square feet, more or less, located  
southerly of Lessor's Norwalk Branch Tracks, so-called,  
and extending between South Professor and South Main  
Streets as shown within lines marked ABCD-A upon blue-  
print of Plan M-6943, dated November 4, 1958.

SECTION 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute  
a lease with the New York Central Railroad Company in accordance with  
said offer.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall take full force and be in  
effect from the earliest period allowed by law.
