

ORDINANCE NO. 89 AC - C.M.S.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR AN ELECTION OF AN AMENDMENT TO THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY THEREFOR

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, five-sevenths of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the question of an amendment to the Charter of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, as hereinafter provided, be submitted to a vote of the qualified electors of the said City in the general election to be held in November 1958. Said amendment being as follows:

(1) That Section XXVII of the Charter of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, shall be added to as follows:

SECTION XXVIII. Hospital

"Any building or buildings and grounds purchased or otherwise acquired by the Municipality for hospital purposes may be leased to a Corporation not for profit for a period not to exceed Ten (10) years, by an affirmative vote of five (5) members of Council in lieu of the Municipality operating said hospital as prescribed in Section 20 of the Charter of the City of Oberlin."

SECTION 2: That the ballot for said election shall at the top thereof be entitled, "Amendment to Charter of Oberlin, Ohio, Ballot" and the question to be submitted on said ballot shall be in words following:

"Shall proposed Section XXVIII of the Charter of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, be adopted?"

That appropriate boxes appear on the ballot giving the voter the right to vote "Yes" or "No" on the issue.

SECTION 3: That the Clerk be, and she is hereby directed to give public notice of the time and place of holding such election by publication of such notice in a newspaper of general circulation in Oberlin, Ohio, at least once per week for three consecutive weeks in the month prior to the date of election, and that a copy of the proposed amendment shall be mailed to each registered voter of the municipality at least thirty days prior to said election.

SECTION 4: That the Clerk be and she is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Ordinance to the Board of Elections of Lorain County.

SECTION 5: That to pay the cost of printing and mailing said copy of said proposed amendment and of publishing said notice there be and hereby is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$50.00 or so much thereof as may be needed.

SECTION 6: This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being the preservation of the safety, health and peace of the citizens of the City of Oberlin and shall take immediate effect upon its passage.
