

ORDINANCE NO. 115 AC - CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF JAMES B.
CLOW & SONS, INC., FOR THE FURNISHING OF
PIPE AND FITTINGS AND TO DECLARE SAME AN
EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain
County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7's) of all members elected thereto con-
curring:

SECTION 1: That the bid of James B. Clow & Sons, Incorporated,
being the lowest and best bid for the furnishing of pipe and fittings, be
and the same is hereby accepted and the City Manager is hereby authorized
to enter into a contract accordingly, the bid being \$15,045.86.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an
emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
peace, safety, property and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio,
to-wit: the preservation of the water system of the City, and shall take
effect immediately upon its passage.
