

ORDINANCE NO. 121 AC - CMS

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH ADDITIONAL DUTIES FOR
THE PERSONNEL OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY
OF OBERLIN, OHIO AND DECLARING SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain
County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7's) of all members elected thereto
concurring:

SECTION 1. Employees of the Fire Department shall in addition
to their regular duties operate the Police radio at all times when
requested by the Police Officer on duty.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency
measure to provide for the public safety, peace and welfare of the citizens
of Oberlin, to-wit: to provide adequate police protection for the citizens
of the City, and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
