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ORDINANCE NO. 131 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF HART  
CONSTRUCTION COMPANY FOR THE FURNISHING  
OF STREET REPAIRING AT THE INTERSECTION  
OF COLLEGE STREET AND MAIN STREET AND TO  
DECLARE SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain  
County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7's) of all members elected thereto  
concurring:

SECTION 1: That the bid of Hart Construction Company being  
the lowest and best bid for the furnishing of street resurfacing at the  
intersection of College and Main Streets, be and the same is hereby  
accepted and the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a  
contract accordingly, the bid being \$1,414.00.

SECTION 2: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an  
emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public  
peace, property and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:  
The preservation of the streets of the City of Oberlin.
