ORDINANCE NO. 135 AC - CMS

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 56 AC CMS AND
CHAPTER 73, CODIFIED ORDINANCES

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of
Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, 5/7 of all members elected thereon concurring:

SECTION 1: Codified Ordinance 373.15 as amended by
Ordinance 56 AC CMS, reads as follows:

"373.15 LICENSE FEE. The license fee to be
paid for each bicycle license shall be fifty cents
(\$0.50) and shall be paid in advance. A license so
issued shall be effective for a twelve (12) month
period commencing on September 1st of each year.
All previous existing licenses issued by the City
of Oberlin shall terminate as of September 1, 1958."

and is hereby amended to read as follows:

"373.15 LICENSE FEE. The license fee to be paid
for each bicycle license shall be fifty cents (\$0.50)
and shall be paid in advance. A license so issued
shall be effective for a twelve (12) month period
commencing on October 31st of each year."

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance is hereby declared
to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation
of the public peace, property and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin,
Ohio, to-wit: The control of bicycle traffic in the City of Oberlin.
