

ORDINANCE NO. 138 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF ZIMMERMAN
COMPANY, INC. FOR CONTRACT A UPGROUND WATERWORKS
IMPROVEMENT RESERVOIR AND APPURTENANCES AND TO
DECLARE SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain
County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the bid of Zimmerman Company, Inc., being the
lowest and best bid for Contract A Upground Waterworks Improvement reservoir
and appurtenances be and the same is hereby accepted and the City Manager is
hereby authorized and the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a
contract accordingly, the bid being \$265,185.75.

SECTION 2: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an
emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
peace, property and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio to-wit: The
installation of necessary waterworks improvements to safeguard the water
supply of the inhabitants of the City of Oberlin.
