

ORDINANCE NO. 145 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF THE TWINING MOTOR SALES, OBERLIN, OHIO, FOR THE FURNISHING OF 1 POLICE CRUISER AND TO DECLARE THE SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Twinig Motor Sales, being the lowest and best bid for the furnishing of one (1) 1960 Ford Police Cruiser be and the same is hereby accepted and the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract accordingly, the bid being net of \$1,850.00.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit: The continued operation of the municipal government.
