

ORDINANCE #151 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF JANBY OIL COMPANY FOR THE FURNISHING OF GASOLINE, CAR WASH AND LUBRICATION, AND TO DECLARE SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, five sevenths (5/7) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the bid of Janby Oil Company, being the lowest and best bid for the furnishing of gasoline, car washing and lubrication, be and the same is hereby accepted and the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract accordingly, the bid being: At station posted price per gallon, less 4¢; bulk, posted price per gallon, less 1¢; car wash, \$2.50; car lubrication, \$2.00; truck lubrication, \$2.50 and \$4.50.

SECTION 2: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit: The providing for the operation of the motor vehicles of the City of Oberlin, and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
