

ORDINANCE NO. 134 AC CMS

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CODIFIED ORDINANCE 741.01,
741.02, 741.03 and 741.04 OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin,
Lorain County, Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto
concurring:

SECTION I. Codified Ordinances 741.01, 741.02, 741.03
and 741.04 are hereby amended to read as follows:

741.01 THROUGH ROUTES.

West bound busses through Oberlin shall proceed on
East Lorain Street from the east corporation line to
North Main Street, south on North Main Street to College
Street, east on East College Street to North Pleasant
Street west on East and West Lorain Streets to the west
corporation line.

741.02 WEST BOUND ROUTES.

Busses west bound from Elyria to Oberlin, and return,
shall proceed on East Lorain Street from the east cor-
poration line to North Main Street, south on North Main
Street to College Street, east on East College Street
to the east corporation line.

741.03 EAST BOUND ROUTES.

East bound busses through Oberlin shall proceed on
West Lorain Street from the west corporation line to
North Main Street, south on North Main Street to College
Street, east on East College Street to the east corpor-
ation line.

741.04 PARKING REGULATIONS.

It shall be unlawful for any motor bus to park or stand
or stop for the purpose of taking on or discharging pass-
engers between Willard Court on East College Street and
the intersection of East College Street and North Main
Street, nor between the intersection of College and Main
Streets and Lorain Street, except at a regular parking
place designated by "Police Orders" for parking purposes.

Motor busses shall for the purpose of taking on or
discharging passengers, park at such parking places as
may be ordered by the Council and designated by police
orders. All busses shall park parallel with the curb
and not more than 2 feet distant therefrom; that not more
than two busses at a time shall be parked at the parking
places so designated unless permission is granted by the

City Manager for the parking of more than two busses
due to special events or college vacation periods.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and
effect from the earliest period allowed by law.
