## CRDINANCE NO. 154 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CODIFIED ORDINANCE 741.01, 741.02, 741.03 and 741.04 OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Chio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SKCTION I. Codified Ordinances 761.01, 741.02, 761.03 and 741.04 are hereby amended to read as follows:

741.01 THROUGH ROUTES.

West bound busses through Oberlin shall proceed on East Lorein Street from the east corporation line to North Main Street, south on North Nain Street to College Street, east on East College Street to North Picasant Street west on East and West Lorein Streets to the west corporation line.

741.62 WEST BOUND ROUTES.

Busces west bound from Elyria to Oberlin, and return, shall proceed on East Lorain Street from the east corporation line to North Haim Street, south on North Main Street to College Street, east on East College Street to the east corporation line.

741.03 RAST BOUND ROUTES.

Bast bound busces through Cherian shall proceed on Mast Lorein Street from the west corporation line to North Main Street, south on North Main Street to College Street, east on East College Street to the east corporation line.

741.04 PARKING REGULATIONS.

It shall be unlewful for any motor bus to park or stand or stop for the purpose of taking on or discharging peasengers between Willard Court on East College Street and the intersection of East College Street and Earth Main Street, nor between the intersection of College and Main Streets and Lordin Street, encept at a regular parking place decignated by "Police Orders" for parking purposes.

Notor busses shall for the purpose of taking on or discharging passengers, park at such parking places as may be ordered by the Council and designated by police orders. All busses shall park parallel with the surb and not more than 2 feet distant therefrom; that not more than two busses at a time shall be perked at the parking places so designated unless permission is granted by the

City Manager for the parking of mora than two busses due to special events or college vacation periods.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the earliest period allowed by law.
