

ORDINANCE §155 AC GMS

AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING A PENALTY FOR DRIVING
A MOTOR VEHICLE IN THE CITY OF OBERLIN WITHOUT
AN OPERATORS OR CHAUFFERS LICENSE

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Oberlin,
Lorain County, Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto
concurring:

SECTION 1. Driver License Required, if
Operator or Chauffeur.

Whoever violates Codified Ordinance 335.01 shall
be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined not more than
\$500.00 or imprisoned not more than six months, or both.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take full force and
be in effect from the earliest period allowed by law.
