

ORDINANCE #156 A C - C M S

AN ORDINANCE ENGAGING THE SERVICES OF THE
FIRM OF LAUNDON & HUFFMAN TO PROVIDE PART
TIME CITY ENGINEERING SERVICES AND DECLARE
SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Oberlin,
Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7) of all members elected
thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the firm of Laundon & Huffman be
retained as part time City Engineer to perform engineering duties
as established in the job description for the position of City
Engineer.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized
to enter into a contract with the firm of Laundon & Huffman to
provide such services as noted in Section 1 for the year 1960, on
the basis of one full day per week, at a price of \$208.00 per
month.

SECTION 3. That Additional services other than
required under said contract shall be at such reasonable rates
as authorized by Council.

SECTION 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an
emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the
public peace, health, and safety of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio,
to-wit: the continued operation of the basic services of the City
of Oberlin, and shall take effect immediately upon it's passage.
