AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE APPLICATION FOR ANNEXATION OF TERRITORY

Price: No. 2. A parcel fronting along the center line of East Hamilton Street a distance of 91.91 feet and adjacent Easterly to R. Lindsey's Sub-

Forcel No. 3. A parcel fronting along the center line of East Hamilton Street a distance of 91.90 feet and adjacent Easterly to property of Clemmie 10 years, as aforesaid, and owned by James and Ethel Thomas.
