

ORDINANCE #160-AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE APPLICATION  
FOR ANNEXATION OF TERRITORY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain  
and State of Ohio, a majority of those members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the application of Roosevelt Lindsey for the annex-  
ation of the following territory in the County of Lorain and adjacent to  
the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit, and hereby accepted:

Consisting of three parcels of land situated in the Township of Russia,  
County of Lorain and State of Ohio, all parcels of Original Russia Township  
Lot No. 106:-

Parcel No. 1. The entirety of R. Lindsey's Subdivision No. 1 as  
recorded in Volume 21, Page 20 of Maps.

Parcel No. 2. A parcel fronting along the center line of East Hamilton  
Street a distance of 91.91 feet and adjacent Easterly to R. Lindsey's Sub-  
division No. 1 and owned by Clammie Abrams.

Parcel No. 3. A parcel fronting along the center line of East Hamilton  
Street a distance of 91.90 feet and adjacent Easterly to property of Clammie  
Abrams, as aforesaid, and owned by James and Ethel Thomas.

The three above parcels together forming a parcel in said Original Russia  
Township Lot No. 106 which is bounded and described as follows:

Beginning in the center line of East Hamilton Street 2.75 feet West of  
the intersection of the center line of South Pleasant Street extended with  
the center line of said East Hamilton Street;

Thence Easterly along the center line of East Hamilton Street, a distance  
of 329.73 feet to a point;

Thence Southerly along the Westerly line of property of John L. Thompson  
a distance of 933.16 feet to an iron pin set;

Thence Westerly in the Northerly line of property now or formerly owned  
by H. W. Reighley a distance of 509.68 feet to an iron pin set;

Thence Northerly along the Easterly line of property now or formerly  
owned by M. D. Wycoff a distance of 937.16 feet to the center line of East  
Hamilton Street and the place of beginning of lands as surveyed by C. E.  
Panfound, Registered Surveyor.

An accurate map of which territory, together with the petition for its  
annexation and other papers relating thereto and a certified transcript of  
the proceedings of the County Commissioners in relation thereto are on file  
with the Clerk of Council of said City, be and the same is hereby accepted.

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
