

CURRYANCE #168 - AC CSE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin,

SECTION 1. The term "intoxicating liquor" as used in the codified Ordinance of the City of Oberlin, or any amendments thereto is hereby defined as follows:

All liquids and compounds, beer, malt, liquor and malt beverages which contain any alcohol regardless of the per cent of alcohol by weight in reference to the total weight and which are fit for human consumption and regardless of source, process or manner of production.

The term "alcohol" as used in the Codified Ordinance of the City of Oberlin or any amendments thereto is hereby defined as follows:

Alcohol means ethyl alcohol, whether rectified or diluted with water or not, whatever its origin may be, and includes synthetic ethyl alcohol. Such term excludes denatured alcohol and wood alcohol.
