

ORDINANCE #170-AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR LEASE BY THE CITY TO ALLEN MEMORIAL HOSPITAL, AN OHIO NON-PROFIT CORPORATION, OF ITS HOSPITAL FACILITIES KNOWN AS ALLEN MEMORIAL HOSPITAL AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY THEREFOR.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Ohio,
Five sevenths (5/7) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City, with the Joint Township Hospital District for Pittsfield, Camden and Russia, enter into lease to Allen Memorial Hospital, an Ohio non-profit corporation, substantially in the form attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and that the City Manager is authorized to execute, seal, acknowledge and deliver such lease on behalf of the City and to cause the City to perform any and all of its obligations under said lease.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being the preservation of the safety, health and peace of the citizens of the City of Oberlin in that said lease makes possible more adequate hospital facilities for the inhabitants of the City, and shall take immediate effect upon its passage.
