

ORDINANCE NO. 175 - AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE PART OF COLLEGE PLACE IN THE
CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO AND DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on the 18th day of July, 1960, a petition by letter was made by all of the persons owning lots abutting on the East and West part of College Place from its intersection with Professor Street to its Northerly curve, Easterly a distance of 270 feet, praying that said College Place from Professor Street, Easterly to the Westerly line of the Northerly part thereof be vacated, and that notice of the filing of said petition was not required by law, and

WHEREAS, Council upon hearing and being satisfied that there was good cause for such vacation as prayed for, and that it will not be harmful to the general public.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain and State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7) of those members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the East and West portion of College Place, a duly dedicated street in the City of Oberlin, running from Professor Street, Easterly 270 feet therefrom, be and the same is hereby vacated.

SECTION 2: This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being the preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the Citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit: To provide for the orderly growth and development of the City of Oberlin, and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
