

**ORDINANCE NO. 181 AC CIS**

ACCEPTING THE BID OF TWINING MOTOR SALES FOR THE FURNISHING OF 1960 FORD F250 CHASSIS AND CAB FOR THE MUNICIPAL ELECTRIC DEPARTMENT AND TO DECLARE THE SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin,  
Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7) of all members  
elected thereto concurring:

**SECTION 1.** That the bid of Twining Motor Sales, being the lowest and best bid for the furnishing of a 1960 Ford F250 Chassis and Cab and the same is hereby accepted and the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract accordingly, the bid being \$1,850.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit: To provide for the daily operation of the municipal light plant and shall take effect immediately on passage.
