

ORDINANCE #183 - AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF THE  
ROWE MOTOR SALES, OBERLIN, OHIO, FOR THE  
FURNISHING OF ONE POLICE CRUISER AND TO  
DECLARE THE SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin,  
Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7) of all members elected  
thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of The Rowe Motor Sales, being  
the lowest and best bid for the furnishing of one (1) 1961  
Plymouth Police Cruiser be and the same is hereby accepted  
and the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a  
contract accordingly, the bid being net of \$1,610.46.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be  
an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation  
of the public peace, property and welfare of the citizens of  
Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit: The continued operation of the Police  
Department of the City and shall take effect immediately upon  
passage.
