CRDINANCE NO. 186 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE EMPLOYMENT OF FINANCIAL ADVISOR

WHEREAS, it is contemplated that the City of Oberlin, Ohio, will proceed with the construction of additions and betterments to the City's Municipal Light Plant which will necessitate the issuance of bonds, and

MMEREAS, the issuance of said bonds and the propagation therefor will necessitate the biring of professional financial advisors, and

WHEREAS, the City has received a satisfactory proposal from Shhey, Clark & Co., Cleveland, Chio, dated October 26, 1960; to render services as financial advisor in the preparation and issuance of the bonds horein-before mentioned, and

.... WHEREAS, this Council believes that the retention of the services of Fakey, Clark & Co. for such purposes would be of benefit and advantage to the City,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE RT CRDAINED by the Council of the City of Cherlin, Ohio, five sevenths (5/7s) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That this Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into a contract with Volvey, Clark & Co., Claveland, Ohio, employing such company as financial advisor to the City of Oberlin, Ohio.

SECTION 2. That for the services described in Section 1, hereof, Fahey, Clark & Co. shall be paid a fee of \$2,450.00.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall be in full some and effect from the earliest period allowed by law.
