ORDINANCE #195 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF INTERNATIONAL HARVESTER COMPANY THROUGH HANNON MOTOR SALES FOR THE FURNISHING OF A TRUCK AND TO DECLARE SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of the International Harvester Company through Hannon Motor Sales, being the lowest and best bid for the furnishing of a truck, be and the same is hereby accepted, and the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract accordingly, the bid being \$2,525.00.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit: The continued operation of the Street Department and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
