

ORDINANCE NO. 199 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF NATIONAL WATER
MAIN CLEANING COMPANY FOR THE CLEANING OF 59,200
LINEAL FEET OF WATER MAIN, AND TO DECLARE SAME AN
EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin,
Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths of the members elected
thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of National Water Main Cleaning
Company, being the lowest and best bid for the cleaning of
59,200 lineal feet of water main, be and the same is hereby
accepted and the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter
into a contract accordingly, the bid being \$14,030.00.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to
be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preser-
vation of the public peace, property and welfare of the
citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit: To provide for the con-
tinuous operation of the waterworks system of Oberlin, Ohio,
and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
