

ORDINANCE 6204 A C C M S

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE OF
THE CITY OF OBERLIN
EMERGENCY**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7a) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 118 and the Zoning Map of the City of Oberlin is hereby amended so as to classify the following described property as R-2.

Situated in the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain and State of Ohio, and being a parcel of land bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the Easterly line of Pyle-S. Amherst Road and the Southwesterly line of W. College Street; thence Southerly in the Easterly line of the Pyle-S. Amherst Road, 344.10 feet; thence Easterly in a line perpendicular to the Easterly line of Pyle-S. Amherst Road, 205 feet; thence Southeasterly in a line parallel to the Southwesterly line of W. College Street, 230 feet; thence Northeasterly in a line perpendicular to the Southwesterly line of W. College Street, 155 feet to the Southwesterly line of W. College Street; thence Northwesterly along the Southwesterly line of W. College Street, 600.75 feet to the place of beginning.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property and welfare of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit: orderly land use development in the City of Oberlin, and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
