AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Chio, five-sevenths (5/7s) of all members elected thereto concurting:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 118 and the Zoning Map of the City of Oberlin is hereby emended so as to classify the following described proporty as R-2.

Situated in the City of Oberlin, County of Lorein and State of Ohio, and being a percel of land bounded and described as follows:

Reginning at the intersection of the Easterly line of Pyle-S. Amberst Road and the Southwesterly line of W. College Street; thence Southerly in the Easterly line of the Pyle-S. Amberst Road, 344.10 feet; thence Easterly in a line perpendicular to the Easterly line of Pyle-S. Amberst Road, 203 feet; thence Southeasterly in a line parallel to the Southwesterly line of W. College Street, 230 feet; thence Morthwesterly in a line perpendicular to the Southwesterly line of W. College Street, 155 feet to the Southwesterly line of W. College Street; thence Worthwesterly along the Southwesterly line of W. College Street; 600.75 feet to the place of beginning.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property and velfare of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit: orderly land use development in the City of Oberlin, and shell take offect immediately upon peacage.
