

ORDINANCE NO. 206 AC C215

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF ROTH BROS.  
FOR THE FURNISHING OF ADDITIONAL HOUSING AND  
MAINTENANCE FOR THE MUNICIPAL LIGHT PLANT  
AND TO DECLARE SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin,  
Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths of all members elected  
thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Roth Bros. being the  
lowest and best bid for the furnishing of additional housing  
and maintenance for the municipal light plant be, and the  
same is, hereby accepted and the City Manager is hereby  
authorized to enter into a contract accordingly, the bid  
being \$49,568.00.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared  
to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate  
preservation of the public peace, property and welfare of  
the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit: To provide for the  
housing for an additional engine and operation of the muni-  
cipal light plant and shall take effect immediately upon  
passage.
