ORDINANCE AMENDING CODIFIED ORDINANCE 351.01

BE IT CREATERD by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, a majority of all mumbers elected therato concurring:

SECTION 1: Codified Ordinance 351.01 is hereby smended to add the following:

(c) No person shall park or leave unattended any motor vehicle either attended or unattended upon that part of the right-of-way of a street which is not part of the paved portion of said street, but is that portion of said street adjacent to said street, and between said street and the outermost line of the right-of-way of said street. Said area being commonly referred to as the tree or curb laws and the sidewalk area.

Any vehicles found so parked or standing shall be removed under the procedure and authority prescribed under Codified Ordinance 351.02.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the earlicat period allowed by law.
