

ORDINANCE #213 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF MARBLE CLIFF  
QUARRIES FOR THE FURNISHING OF CALCIUM OXIDE  
AND TO DECLARE THE SAME AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin,

Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths of all members elected there-  
to  
to concurring:

SECTION 1: That the bid of Marble Cliff Quarries being  
the lowest and best bid for the furnishing of Calcium Oxide be,  
and the same is, hereby accepted and the City Manager is author-  
ized to enter into a contract accordingly, the bid being \$17.25  
per ton and \$15.86 per ton.

SECTION 2: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be  
an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation  
of the public peace, prosperity and welfare of the citizens of  
Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit: To provide for the daily operation of  
the water works department and shall take effect immediately  
upon passage.
