

ORDINANCE NO. 218 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF T. O. MURPHY CO.
FOR THE FURNISHING OF MECHANICAL WORK FOR THE MUNI-
CIPAL LIGHT PLANT EXPANSION AND TO DECLARE SAME AN
EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL of the City of Oberlin,
Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths of all members elected
thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of T. O. Murphy Co. being the
lowest and best bid for the furnishing of Mechanical Work for
the Municipal Light Plant be, and the same is, hereby accepted
and the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a con-
tract accordingly, the bid being \$66,900.00.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be
an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of
the public peace, property and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin,
Ohio, to-wit: To provide for the operation of an additional en-
gine and operation of the municipal light plant and shall take
effect immediately upon passage.
