

ORDINANCE NO. 222 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF STANDARD
OIL COMPANY FOR THE FURNISHING OF FUEL OIL
TO MUNICIPAL LIGHT PLANT

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin,
Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths of all members elected
thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the bid of Standard Oil Co., being the
lowest and best bid for the furnishing of fuel oil for the
Municipal Light Plant be and the same is hereby accepted and
the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract
accordingly, the bid being: .1027 maximum.

SECTION 2: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an
emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of
the public peace, property and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin,
Ohio, to-wit: To provide for proper maintenance of the Municipal
Light Plant and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
