

ORDINANCE NO. 223 AG CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF HART CONSTRUCTION CO. FOR STREET IMPROVEMENTS TO GLENHURST DRIVE AND TO DECLARE THE SAME AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin,
Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths of all members elected thereto
concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Hart Construction Co. being the lowest and best bid for Street Improvements to Glenhurst Drive be, and the same is, hereby accepted and the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract accordingly, the bid being .65¢ per sq. yard and for an estimated total cost of \$2,250.00.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit: To permit safe and reasonable vehicular passage over the street right-of-way.
