

ORDINANCE NO. 226 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SOLICITOR OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO, TO EMPLOY SPECIAL COUNCIL TO ASSIST HIM IN THE PROCEEDINGS FOR THE ISSUANCE OF NOTES OF THE CITY IN ORDER TO FINANCE THE IMPROVEMENT OF HOLLYWOOD STREET IN SAID CITY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Ohio:

Section 1. That the City Solicitor be and he is hereby authorized to employ the law firm of Squire, Sanders and Dempsey of Cleveland, Ohio, Municipal Bond Attorneys, to prepare and supervise the essential proceedings and legislation in connection with the authorization and issuance of a note in anticipation of the issuance of bonds and the levy and collection of special assessments to pay the costs of improving Hollywood Street between certain termini by installing a storm sewer, curbs and gutters as required and paving together with necessary appurtenances and render an approving opinion thereon.

Section 2. That for the aforesaid services said firm shall be paid a fee now estimated at \$215.00 and in addition thereto expense of long distance telephone calls, telegrams and other out-of-pocket expenses, which sum is hereby set aside and appropriated to such purpose, and the Auditor is hereby authorized and directed to make appropriate certification as to the availability of such funds and to issue an appropriate order for payment of such fee as the same shall become payable.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
