

ORDINANCE NO. 227 AS CMB

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE EASEMENT

WHEREAS, on the 7th day of August, 1961, the Council of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, adopted Resolution No. 443, declaring the necessity and intention of appropriating the land hereinafter described, notice of the adoption of which resolution has been served on the owners, persons in possession and having an interest of record in said premises, and now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, five-sevenths of all members elected three concurring.

SECTION 1. That the fee simple interest in and to the following described real estate be and the same is hereby appropriated for the public purpose of street improvements.

Situated in the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain and State of Ohio, and being part of Original Russia Township Lot No. 75, and further bounded and described as follows:

Commencing at the Northerly corner of premises deeded to the City of Oberlin under date of July 7, 1955, as recorded in Volume 635, Page 264, of Lorain County Record of Deeds; thence North  $0^{\circ} 37'$  East a distance of 4.92 feet to a point on the Southerly line of a 16' alley; thence Westerly along the Southerly line of the 16' alley; 60.04' to a point on the Easterly line of premises now or formerly owned by Helen B. Morrison; thence Southerly along the Easterly line of said Helen B. Morrison property, a distance of 4.61' to a point being the Northwest corner of premises deeded to the City of Oberlin as aforesaid; thence Easterly along the Northerly line of premises so deeded to the City of Oberlin, about 60.04' to the place of beginning and containing about .006 of an acre, and being the same premises conveyed to the North Prospect Park Association by deed recorded in Volume 668, Page 584, Lorain County Record of Deeds.

SECTION 2. That the City Solicitor be and he is hereby authorized and directed to apply to a court of competent jurisdiction to have a jury empaneled to make inquiry into and assess the compensation to be paid for the fee simple interest in said property.'

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the earliest period allowed by law.
